

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) Subsidy

Ohio families may be eligible for childcare assistance through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) if they are working, in school, or job training.

To help navigate the process, here's a general overview of how it works:

Step 1: Check Eligibility

Step 2: Tour Kid Works & Learn About Enrollment

If you find that you may qualify and are considering Kid Works for your child's care, the next step is to <u>schedule a tour at your preferred center.</u> During your visit, we'll walk you through our curriculum, tuition structure, available schedules, and more. It's also a great opportunity to meet our educators and explore the learning environment.

Step 3: Application Review Period

After submitting your application, ODJFS will review it and may reach out for more information.

In the meantime, you have two options:

- Start immediately by paying a temporary weekly rate of \$25. If approved, any overpayments will be credited back to you.
- Wait to begin care until your official ODJFS approval is received, which will include your coverage details and start date.
